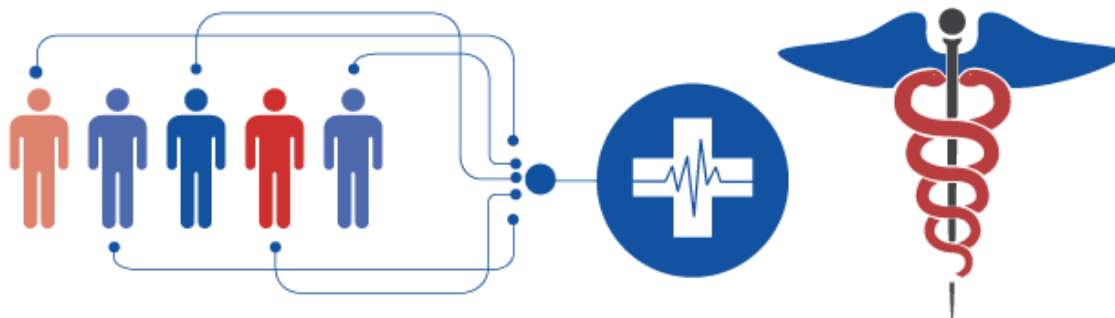

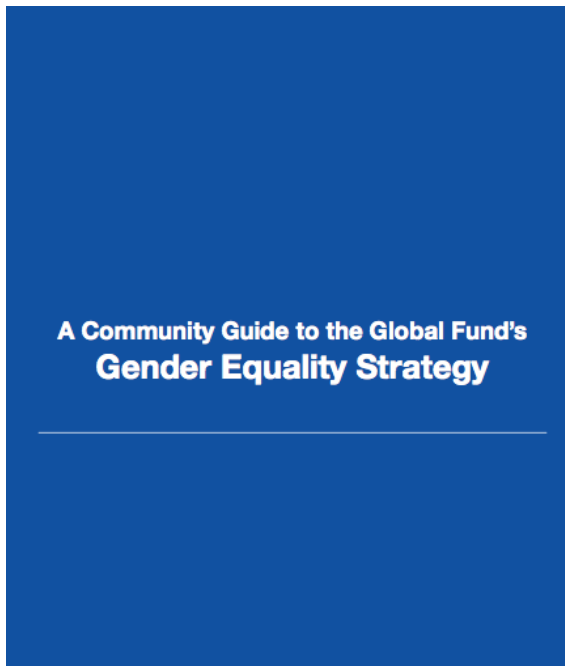
This community guide is a basic overview of the Global Fund's Gender Equality Strategy.
