## Final List of Pledges from the Global Fund's 5<sup>th</sup> Replenishment



Greetings from the Regional Platform for Communication and Coordination for Anglophone Africa, hosted by EANNASO.

From 16-17 September 2016, governments, private donors and advocates from around the world gathered in Montreal, Canada to replenish the Global Fund for the 2017-2019 grant cycle. In total, more than \$12.9 billion was pledged, nearly reaching the Fund's target of \$13 billion.

Ten African countries contributed more than \$30 million to the 5<sup>th</sup> Global Fund replenishment, including pledges from Benin, Cote d'Ivoire, Kenya, Namibia, Nigeria, Senegal, South Africa, Togo, Zambia and Zimbabwe.
