The Global Fund has approved a short-term technical assistance (TA) investment in Community-Led Monitoring (CLM) for effective C19RM which aims to responding to community needs on the ground.

## WHAT IS CLM?

The Global Fund defines CLM as models of mechanisms by which service users and/or local communities gather, analyze, and use information on an ongoing basis to improve access to, quality and impact of services, and to hold service providers and decision makers accountable.
